PLAYERS

Players may range from ages 10-18 and are admitted to the team by invitation of the PCC coaching staff.

OBJECTIVE

To provide intensive training in a team atmosphere for junior players highly motivated to improve their level and compete well in Nor Cal USTA junior tournaments.

To learn how to be both a mentor and to be mentored by other players. Each team member will be expected to help other teammates of both higher and lower levels to improve their games.

PROGRAM: *September 2—December 14*

(No practices 9/15-18 due to coach's conference)

Training

On court practice ***Mondays*** and ***Wednesdays*** from **5:30–7:00pm**; ***Tuesdays*** and ***Thursdays*** from **5:00-6:00pm**

Fitness training ***Tuesdays*** and ***Thursdays*** from **4:00-5:00pm**

Sunday match play from **3:00 - 5:00pm**. (No match play on tournament weekends.)

A portion of practice times will be used off court in areas of mental toughness, video analysis of strokes, strategies and chalk talks.

Tournaments

As a team, we will enter an average of one USTA tournament per month. PCC coaches will be at the tournaments to watch the team members compete, charting their match progress and identifying areas of strength and potential improvement.

PLAYERS & FAMILIES RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Attend all practices and fitness training and be on time!
2. Wear practice shirts to all on court practices and wear team warm-ups to all tournaments.
3. School first policy—Players must maintain a B average and have no single grade below a C to remain on the team.
4. Players and families are responsible to provide transportation to and from tournaments. However, carpooling and riding with coaches will be encouraged to the fullest.
